## SSI and Medicaid Terms to Know

| Adjudicator | Disability Determination Services employee who reviews cases to see if an <br> individual meets the criteria for disability. |
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| Appeal for Reconsideration | Stage of review following initial denial; opportunity to have your case reviewed <br> by a different Adjudicator and to provide additional information. |
| Blue Book | Identifies criteria and documentation needed for medical determination of <br> disability. |
| Compassionate Allowance | Used for quick determinations of disability for some conditions (see Blue Book <br> listing). |
| Hearing | After loss at reconsideration level, a hearing presents an opportunity for <br> interaction with the Administrative Law Judge. |
| Means-tested | Defines limitations in income and resource limits for Medicaid eligibility. |
| Mental Residual Functional <br> Capacity | Some disabling conditions require documentation of severity and impact as <br> demonstrated through diminished mental residual functional capacity in order to <br> secure a determination of disability. Criteria for diminished mental residual <br> functional capacity includes Understanding, Processing \& Memory; <br> Concentration, Persistence \& Pace; Social Interaction; Adaptability. |
| Physical Residual <br> Functional Capacity | Some disabling conditions require documentation of severity and impact as <br> demonstrated through diminished physical residual functional capacity in order <br> to secure a determination of disability. Limitations in movements and exertion <br> are documented in this category |
| Red Book | A listing of all the rules for Social Security beneficiaries who are working while <br> receiving SSI and SSDI; this explains work incentives and safety net programs |
| SSA | Social Security Administration <br> SSI Supplemental Security Income |
| SSDI | Social Security Disability Insurance |
