





Your Medicaid Redetermination Timeline

The State of Georgia will check to see if you're still eligible for coverage. Take charge by marking dates and following these steps.

WHAT TO DO TODAY:

Confirm your contact info at gateway.ga.gov and get your redetermination date.

Receive redetermination letter or email. Keep track of dates and requests.	You will receive a reminder that your coverage eligibility decision is coming soon. Prepare and submit any requested documents ASAP.	Paperwork due. If eligible, this is your renewal date. If not, this is your expiration date.	If you have been denied coverage and believe there is an error, you can request a fair hearing within 30 days of your denial notice.
